This pledge was devised by the pupils in our e-safety sessions.

To use the internet in a safe and responsible way:

- We will never share any personal information online such as home address, full name, school and password.
- We will not search for inappropriate pictures online
- We will not go on websites that we are not allowed to visit.
- We will tell the teacher if anything strange pops up.
- We will not share private photos of ourselves or other people online.
- We will only play on age related and appropriate games.
- We will not cyber bully anyone online.
- We will not make YouTube videos without permission.
- We will not watch inappropriate YouTube videos.
- We will not talk to strangers online.
- We will not use naughty/ offensive language online.
- We will not buy things without permission from our parents.
- We will not open spam messages or messages from people we don't know.
- We will never share our own or parent's bank details.
- We will not tell people where we are going.
- We will report any cyber bullying to a trusted adult.
- We will not hack anybody's account.
- We will not share embarrassing things about other people.
- We will not sign into anybody' else's account.
- We will make our passwords hard to guess but easy to remember.
- We will be careful online.
- We will not agree to meet up with anyone we don't know.
- We will not trust that everyone is who they say they are.
- We will not create inappropriate games on Scratch or any other website.
- We will set any social media accounts to private.
- We will ask a trusted adult if you are unsure about a website.
- We will keep any social media settings as private.
