In this dreamland far away.*

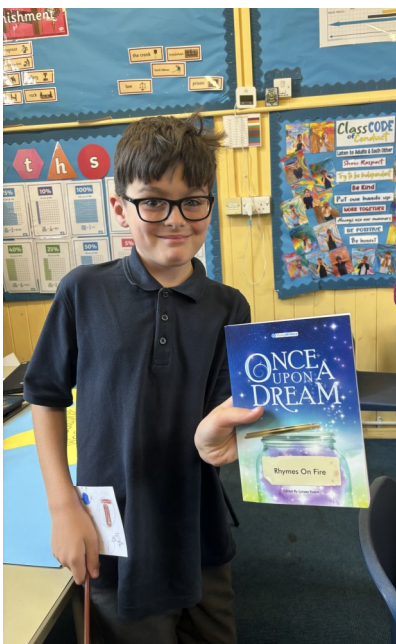
