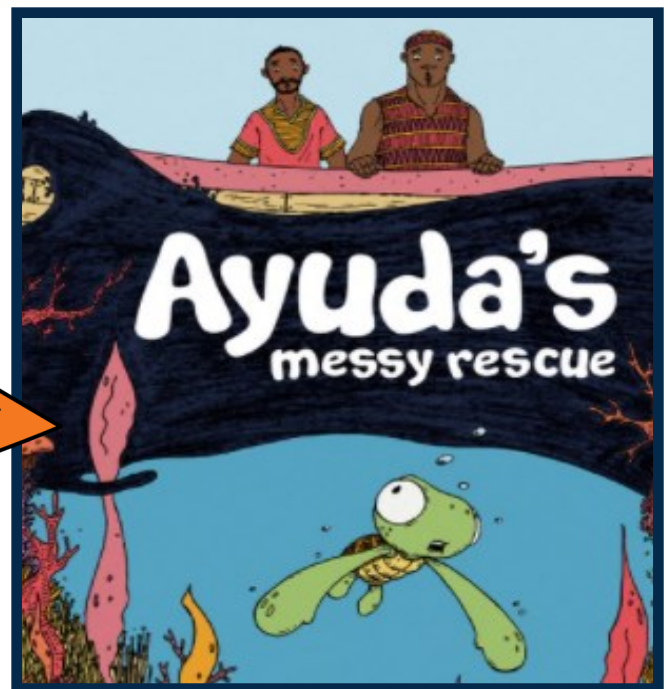


# Ayuda's Messy Rescue
