Directions	Questions
Begin on School Lane.	Question 1
Head up on to The Market Place.	Question 2 and 3
Turn left onto The Common (Question 4 is just past the turning to Sun lane so you will have to back track slightly).	Question 4
Go up Sun Lane.	
Continue on to Chapel Lane.	
Turn right on the footpath up the steps to the top of The Tors.	
Turn left and walk across the top of the 4 fields. Take the right hand path down to gate at the bottom of the last field.	
Turn right onto Cowper Lane.	
Then take the footpath on the left.	
This footpath will bring you out on to Sandy Lane.	
Turn left on Sandy Lane towards the farm across the road.	
At the farm follow the footpath (past the geese) back up into Crich.	
Go through the gate onto Chase View.	
Turn left onto Bulling Lane.	
Bear left and continue up to Coasthill.	
Follow the bridle way straight through the bottom of the fields.	
At the road, cross over to the Tramway side of the road and walk left up the hill.	
Follow the footpath up to Crich Stand at the side of Plaistow Green Road.	
Walk up to Crich Stand.	Questions 6 and 7
Follow the same footpath back down towards the main road.	Question 8
At the main road, follow paths towards the church.	Questions 9 & 10
When you leave the church, cross the road and continue left until you reach the gitty at Wheatsheaf cottage (Wheatsheaf Lane) and turn right on to it.	Question 11
Turn left down coast hill and on to Bulling Lane.	
Look for the footpath by the tunnel and head on to The Recreation Ground.	Question 12/13
