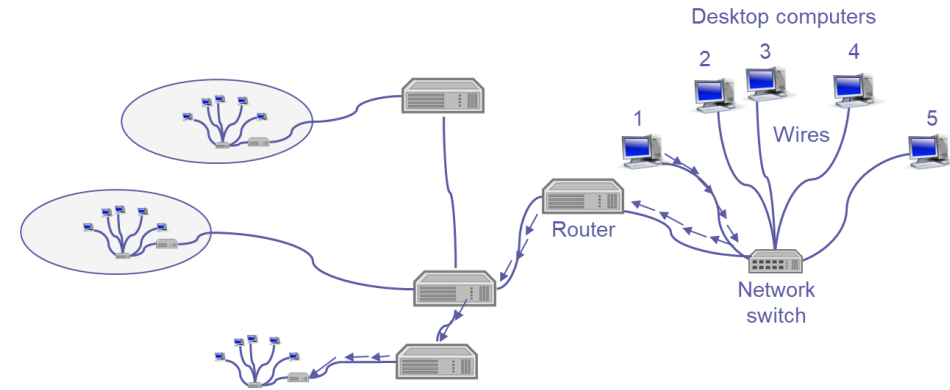


The Internet

Digital device	A device that has an input, process and output.
Internet	The internet is a network of lots of computers connected to each other.
Network	A computer network is lots of connections that joins computers together.
Network Switch	A network switch connects a number of devices together by passing information.
Router	A device which directs information around the internet
Website	A website is a collection of pages, under one name
Webpage	A single page or document on the world wide web.
World Wide Web	The World Wide Web is part of the internet where we can visit web pages and websites.
Web browser	Lets you look (browse) web pages on the internet. Chrome, Safari, Edge
