After school clubs – after this week, there are no more after school clubs until September.

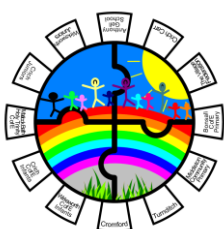
Festival of Fun – 13th – 17th July
